**A God of the Nights?**  
Except the night Christ was born and betrayed...Exodus 12:29 And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle...is the most momentous night in the history of mankind. Some of God's mightiest acts in the drama of providence and redemption have taken place at night. This night, when the sun set, Israel was a nation of slaves, hugging its chains. When the sun rose, Israel was a nation on the move following a fiery pillar and cloudy path of God's eternal purpose to redeem mankind. This night all of Egypt is asleep. All is past the hailstones, the frogs, the diseases, the blood, the locusts, the darkness that could be felt...all 9 plagues are past. But this night, the awful climax of judgment, not a single Jew slave is to be seen, and on the doors of every slave's hut and home is the stain of blood. Their staffs in hand, loins girted, shoes on and every one with a look of expectation and dread, as midnight approaches, what they had been waiting for! There arose a great cry, a long wail of woe, a wave of lamentation that swept over the whole land. Pharaoh awoke with a sense of dread. He called for his son only to learn that the Prince of the realm, his first born son was dead! "From the first born of Pharaoh to the first born of cattle." Death reigned! Death! Death! Death! Death in the temple! Death in the cottage! Death in the streets! Death in the dungeon! Death on the river! Death on the highway! Death in the fields! Death! Death! Everywhere a moan of anguish went up to Egypt's skies. But where the blood of the slain lamb had been sprinkled, there was no death. The Angel of Death passed over these homes. Pharaoh screamed for Moses and Aaron, telling them "Go you and the children of Israel, go serve your Lord." That night Israel was on the move, the hour of deliverance had come. God's plan and purpose was on the march. A journey that will not end until the whole world has been redeemed. (God's Retribution... remember that cruel Pharaoh who had issued every male child be cast into the Nile? That night when thousands of first born were cruelly carried away and cast into the river like trash, God was not sleeping, he was keeping watch over his own...Retribution, God's way all across the land.)  
God's Purpose is invincible. Egypt, who had saved Israel one time, wasn't able to destroy them or Gods purpose. Even with the pause and delay of several centuries- God is never in a hurry- His plan and purpose march on to its goal when the hour is darkest and everything seems to conspire against the TRUTH, even in a night like this, God knows how to save His people...One of the greatest truths of that night is wherever the blood was applied, God delivered through Christ who bore our sins upon the cross and died for us and that by his death we live! 1400 years have passed since that night, where they stood ready, loins girted and staffs in hand, ready for the cry of Egypt that sounded their march of freedom. That night was remembered by/as the Feast of Passover, the very name "Passover", passed over because of the blood.  
Now on this night the disciples came to Jesus and ask him "where wilt thou that we prepare thee to eat the Passover?" Luke 22:7-20  
Arrangements made, upper chamber prepared, Jesus sits with them to eat the Passover and so as mind running back to that night of great deliverance that God did through the blood of the lamb on the doorposts. Jesus institutes a new feast that will forever be the theme of angels and the redeemed through all eternity. He broke the bread and said "This is my body, which is broken for you" and poured out the cup and said "This cup is the New Testament in my blood which is shed for many for the remission of sins: drink ye all of it". On this night what is the meaning of it? It is that Christ is the Lamb of God slain from the foundations of the world. That's what John was saying when he said Christ was the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sins of the world. 1Corinthians 5: 7 Paul said "Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us" and Isaiah "He was wounded for our transgressions and bruised for our iniquities and by his stripes we are healed." This is the Glory and Power and the Heart of the Gospel in the fact that Christ died for me, as my substitute.  
Sometimes God uses the nights of our lives. It is of little doubt that America is in a dark night with the violence, drugs, kids having kids, with the social, culture and moral decay we are in a dark night....God is the GOD OF THE NIGHT! His word states "But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound". As the days ahead look darker and darker, our prayer for this week is....  
"OH LORD, HELP US TO SEE OUR NEED OF YOU OVER AND OVER AGAIN, LORD HAVE MERCY UPON US AS A NATION, AS A STATE, AS A COUNTY, AS FAMILIES LORD REVIVE A DEEP LOVE IN OUR HEARTS, AS YOUR GRACE FLOWS THROUGH OUR FAMILY, OUR COUNTY, OUR STATE AND OUR NATION. HELP US TO EXPERIENCE A LIFE CHANGED, CHALLENGED, AND CHARGED FOR YOU-AMEN."



## Photo ID required when voting in person

Montague County Election Administrator, Brandi Shipman, reminds voters that photo identification will now be required for voting in person.

"In Montague County we are working to make sure our voters understand the new ID requirements and have all the information they need to cast their ballots," said Shipman.

A voter will be required to show one of the following forms of photo identification at the polling location before the voter will be permitted to cast a vote:

- Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)

- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS

- Texas personal identification card issued by DPS

- Texas concealed handgun license issued by DPS

- United States military identification card containing the person's photograph

- United States citizenship certificate containing the person's photograph

- United States passport

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the identification must be current or have expired no more than 60 days before being presented at the polling place.

This photo ID requirement is for voters casting a ballot in person, not by mail. Voters age 65 and older may vote by mail.

Election officials are encouraging voters to update their voter registrations to reflect the names on their IDs. Voters may use IDs that do not exactly match the name on their IDs if the names are

substantially similar but will have to sign an affidavit stating they are the same person. Voters may look up their registration at [votetexas.gov](http://votetexas.gov) and if their name is not an exact match they can update their voter registration online at [votetexas.gov](http://votetexas.gov).

"By preparing now, voters can help make sure voting goes smoothly when it comes time for the election," said Shipman.



## Yellow Squash Cupcakes with Chocolate Frosting



### Ingredients For the Cupcakes:

- \*Baking spray
- \*1 cup plus 2 tablespoons (about 5 3/4 ounces) all-purpose flour
- \*1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- \*1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- \*1/2 teaspoon salt
- \*1/2 teaspoon ground cardamom
- \*4 tablespoons (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, at room temperature
- \*1/4 cup vegetable oil
- \*3/4 cup (about 5 1/4 ounces) packed light brown sugar
- \*1 tablespoon grated orange zest from 1 orange
- \*2 large eggs, at room temperature
- \*2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- \*1/4 cup sour cream
- \*1 cup coarsely grated yellow squash, from about one 8-ounce squash (see note above)

### Ingredients For the Frosting

- \*4 tablespoons (1/2 stick) unsalted butter
- \*8 ounces cream cheese, at room temperature
- \*2 cups confectioners' sugar
- \*1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- \*1/4 teaspoon salt
- \*4 ounces bittersweet chocolate, melted and slightly cooled

## Did You Know?

Who knew that one of America's first beloved cereals was invented by accident?

It all started with Will Keith Kellogg, his interest in medicine and a bout of forgetfulness. Kellogg assisted his brother, who worked as a doctor at the Battle Creek Sanitarium in Michigan, with patients and their diets. While conducting research with his brother and helping cook meals for patients, Kellogg stumbled upon a discovery that would change his life.

Responsible for making bread dough one day, Kellogg accidentally left his main ingredient, boiled wheat, sitting out for several hours. When he came back to roll the ingredient into dough, the wheat became flaky. Curious to see what would happen, Kellogg baked the flaky dough anyway, creating a crunchy and flaky snack. The flakes were a hit with patients, so Kellogg embarked on a mission to enhance the product for large-scale sale.

Will Kellogg tinkered with his recipe and finally settled on using corn as a main ingredient for the flakes. He launched his business, "The Battle Creek Toasted Corn Flakes Company," in 1906, which eventually came to be known as the Kellogg's company that sells Corn Flakes, other cereals and convenience foods today.

## Crunch A Bunch Cupcakes

### Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 package (10 oz., about 40) regular marshmallows - OR - 4 cups miniature marshmallows
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 1/2 teaspoon strawberry extract
- 6 cups Kellogg's® Rice Krispies® cereal
- Canned frosting or decorating gel



**Montague County Child Welfare Board**

The Montague County Child Welfare Board is a group of 15 volunteers who support the abused and neglected children of Montague County in CPS care. Currently there are approximately 41 children in CPS custody. Three quarters of these children are placed with relatives. Family members often take in these children to keep them in the area and to keep them from being placed with strangers. The responsibility of more children to care for, many times, creates a financial hardship. Sometimes it is grandparents who are living on a retirement income who take in the children. There are another 40 families, with approximately 65-75 more children, involved in family based services. In 2011, the state rate of confirmed victims of child abuse was 9.9% of the total child population. That number for Montague County in the same year was 27.3%. The state rate of children placed in Foster Care was 4.6%. For Montague County the number of chil-

ren placed in Foster Care was 15.9%. Since drug abuse is the main cause of child abuse in our county, the Child Welfare Board sponsors a drug education program with the theme "Not Even Once", every other year for all the county schools. These programs have been presented to student in grades 6-12. Graphic video clips are used in the presentation to drive home the point of "Not Even Once". They really make an impression on the students. This program is tentatively scheduled for October of this year. We truly believe that education is the key to stopping this cycle of drug and/or child abuse in our county. So in an effort to do more drug education and awareness, next school year the CWB is proposing to have one day per 6 weeks for a drug education lesson and a "Not Even Once" theme. Hopefully, this will take place on the same day in all 7 school districts in the county. We are hoping that

re-visiting this subject each 6 weeks will keep the idea of the dangers of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol fresh on the minds of our children. A curriculum has been ordered through the National Institute on Drug Abuse. This curriculum provides an age and grade appropriate lesson focused mainly on the brain and how taking drugs will affect it. The dates for the "Not Even Once" Wednesdays are: September 18, 2013; October 16, 2013-Elementary, Jr. High and High School students will attend the "Not Even Once" assembly; November 20, 2013; January 29, 2014; March 19, 2014; April 30, 2014. How can you help? Wear Red to show your support for this program on these dates and put "Not Even Once" on your business or church sign on these dates. If we all work together maybe we can make a difference for these children and Montague County!

**Order Restricting Outdoor Burning**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that circumstances present in all of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, by the Commissioners Court of Montague County that all outdoor burning is banned in the unincorporated areas of the county for 90 days from the date of adoption of this Order unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by the Texas Forest Service or this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code Section 352.081, and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public

health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Natural Resources Commission for (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) harvesting of agricultural crop; or (4) welding allowed with restrictions listed below:  
 \*area should be clean 15 ft. or more on welding site  
 \*there should be at least 55 gallons of water with the ability to pressurize & spray welding site  
 \*an additional person should be onsite with welder to spot fires  
 \*a fire extinguisher on welding site.  
 (5) outdoor cooking allowed with the restrictions listed below:  
 \*the cooking device is propane or natural gas and has a complete and full enclosure that is utilized at all times or

\*the cooking device is wood or charcoal and has a complete and full enclosure that is utilized, and all areas around the cooking device shall be clear of vegetation and/or combustible materials or debris for a 5' radius. In accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500. The Montague County Judge may rescind this Order upon a determination that the circumstances that required the Order no longer exist. This burn ban was put into effect on August 26, 2013.

tague County. Proceeds from the rodeo will be awarded to those various youth groups. This big event will be on Saturday, September 14th, beginning at 7:30 p.m., and Sunday, September 15th, beginning at 3:00 p.m. at the Bowie Rodeo Arena. For more information, sponsorship, etc., call 940-841-3093.

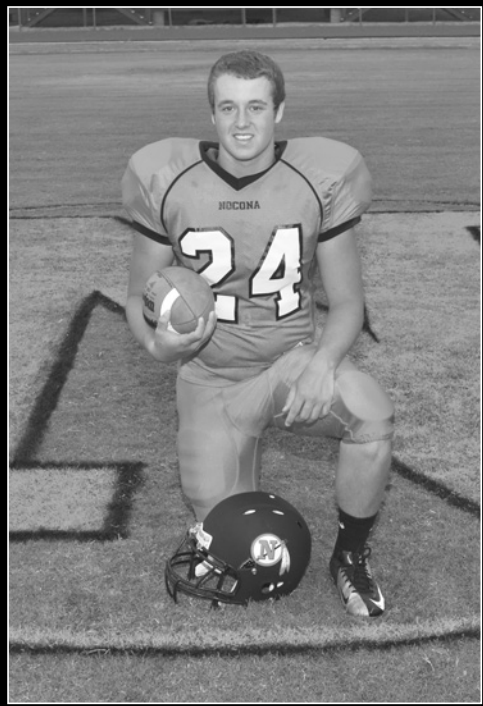

## How hurricanes affect the ecosystem

Hurricanes and other strong storms can have a profound impact on communities. Power outages, flooding and interruption of communication systems can interrupt everyday life. But storms and natural disasters can wreak havoc on animals, ecosystems and coastal habitats.

Although parts of the world have been subjected to hurricanes, typhoons, tornadoes and other storms for millenia, experts at the United States Department of the Interior and the U.S. Geological Survey say that today's storms may be more detrimental to animal life and ecosystems than ever before. That's because periodic disturbances on plants and animals that result from storms are compounded by consistent environmental changes brought on by human development and industry. Animals that could once bounce back from a weather event may find it harder to rebound because their habitats have already been weakened by human interference.

In 1998, Hurricane Georges was the most destructive hurricane to strike the island of Puerto Rico since 1932. Georges further stressed the habitat of rare species such as the sea turtle and the highly endangered Puerto Rican parrot, cutting the parrot population in half. Conservation specialists

estimate there are fewer than 50 of these parrots currently living in the wild and roughly 140 in captivity.

Thousands of animals live in coastal regions. In addition to high, damaging winds taking down trees and defoliating forest canopies, wind can cause powerful storm surges that displace sand. Ultimately, entire coastal landscapes may be reshaped or reduced. Information from the University of Rhode Island estimates that hurricanes such as Ivan, Katrina, Rita, Gustav, and Ike have changed shoreline positions of about 328 feet (100 meters) in certain areas. Northeastern coastal areas in New York, New Jersey and Connecticut have been entirely reshaped in the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy. Wildlife that may have been living in the dunes or coastal channels of areas impacted by hurricanes and other storms may have been obliterated or forced to relocate to other, less tolerable locations. Barrier islands, important for protecting areas of the coast, shift or erode, taking out forests that are resting places for migratory birds. Should a storm take place during a period of mating or egg-laying, entire generations of animal life can be wiped out.

Coastal areas are not the only places impacted by such storms. During Hurricane

Sandy, seawater breached many areas that had never before seen such a surge in water levels. Saltwater intrusion can change other wetland ecosystems, making them uninhabitable for some organisms not acclimated to salty conditions. Displaced sand can end up suffocating insects and other animals in areas where it has been dumped, and may impede the growth of grasses and other plants that feed a wide variety of animals.

Hurricanes can affect marine life as well. Hurricanes can destroy oyster beds and crab habitats and displace fish that feed many other large marine creatures. Flood waters can transport sewage and untreated chemicals from land into the water, harming marine life as a result. Fish and crustaceans may be tossed on shore, where they are unable to return to the safety of the water. Furthermore, discharge of boat fuel and oil from wrecked vessels can infiltrate marine ecosystems, further damaging delicate species.

Hurricanes can cause structural changes, interruption of food sources and destruction of homes while slowing down communication methods. But hurricanes affect the animals that live in and around storm-ravaged areas as well.
